Specific Subject: Term Limitations for Appointments of Members to the Planning
Commission, Design Review Board and the Housing and Redevelopment
Advisory Committee

PURPOSE: In order to provide more citizen participation in decisions
affecting Carlsbad, appointments to the Planning Commission,
Design Review Board and Housing & Redevelopment Advisory
Committee, shall be limited to two consecutive terms.

POLICY:

1. The City Council of the City of Carlsbad will appoint members of the Planning Commission, Design Review Board, and Housing and Redevelopment Advisory Committee to a maximum of two consecutive terms.
2. An individual retiring after two terms will be immediately eligible for consideration for any other board, commission or committee, or could be reconsidered for appointment to the same board or commission after a two year waiting period.
3. Individuals initially appointed to an unexpired term would be eligible to be reappointed for two consecutive terms.
4. The City Council may make an exception to this policy and extend an individual's term if there are extenuating circumstances, such as the need for a suitable number of experienced members. The extension shall not exceed one year and can be granted only one time.
